KUNOS Maintenance No. 1878

N means LIVOS neutral for the allergy-prone and chemically sensitive

Application range In the interior, as protection and maintenance of surfaces treated with KUNOS oils (No. 240 – 245)

as well as SAMO No. 698, e.g. kitchen countertops, tables and floors. Not suitable for stained

wood or cabinet interior surfaces.

Technical qualities Free of terpenes and cobalt. Produces a satin-glossy surface after the treatment. Complies with

the German Industrial Norm DIN 53 160 for color fastness when exposed to perspiration and

saliva. Suitable for toys according to DIN EN 71 Part 3.

Full declaration Isoaliphates, linseed oil - stand oil - natural resin ester, castor oil - natural resin ester, wood oil,

linseed oil, natural resin glycerol ester, micronized wax, silica, dehydrated amino sugar,

carnauba wax, shellac wax, beeswax, walnut oil and drying agents free of lead (Mn, Zr).

Colors Clear 002

Dilution Ready to use.

Application method With a lint-free cotton cloth or single disc rotary machine and felt pad, at temperatures above

15°C (59°F).

Coverage To be determined by a test application. Approximately 10 ml/m2, could be considerably more or

less, depending on the absorbency and condition of the KUNOS-surface.

Cleaning Clean equipment immediately after use with LEVO Brush Cleaner No. 997.

Drying time At 23°C (73 °F) and 50% relative humidity: 4 - 8 hours.

Specific gravity Approximately 0.87 g/ml.

Safety advice Ensure good ventilation during and after application. Always be sure to store and then dispose

of cleaning cloths, polishing pads, sponges, etc. that are still wet or even slightly moist with KUNOS Maintenance No. 1878 in an airtight metal container or in water, as there is a danger of spontaneous combustion caused by the plant oil content. The product itself will not combust

spontaneously.

EUH066 Repeated exposure may cause skin dryness or cracking.

Disposal According to locally regulated laws.

Container sizes 0.25 l; 0.75 l; 2.5 l.

Storage Cool and dry. Shelf life: unopened at least 4 years. Transfer unused product into smaller

container for storage in order to minimize excess air.

How to use

KUNOS Maintenance No. 1878

Preparation The KUNOS surface to be maintained must be dry, clean and dust-free. Deep scratches and

damages should be eliminated with the initial treatment product.

Application Stir thoroughly before use. Remove possible skin formed on surface.

Test application!

Apply KUNOS Maintenance dropwise (approx. $5 - 10 \text{ g/m}^2$) on the surface to be maintained, and polish immediately with little pressure using a single disc rotary machine and felt pad or a lint-

free cotton cloth. Avoid streak formation. Check in the backlight.

You may repeat the process.

Clean with TRENA pH-Neutral Cleaner No. 556 added to water, and wipe moist but not wet.

After-treatment with KUNOS Maintenance No. 1878, depending on the use several times a year.

Important tips If a coarse-grained abrasive pad is used with a single disc rotary machine to polish KUNOS

Maintenance, the color intensity of an existing pigmented coating might decrease or the oil-resin

coating could be removed.
